When Fr. George's camera was stolen by a child living on the streets in Uganda in 2012, he made it his mission to give underpriveledged children the opportunity to improve their lives.

Since 2014, thanks to the generous donations generated primarily by St. Louis families, the Broader Vision School has grown from a small single story school building to a three building boarding school serving more than 450 Ugandan children - more than half of whom were previously living on the street.

Funds raised by your generous doniations during this Lenten season will help Fr. George continue his mission to serve these children through assistance with annual tuition, housing for the faculty, a safe cooking space and food for the school.
