Featured Leader - Amelia Mary Earhart (born July 24, 1897; disappeared July 2, 1937; declared dead January 5, 1939) was an American aviation pioneer and writer. Earhart was the first female aviator to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean. She set many other records.

She was one of the first aviators to promote commercial air travel. She wrote best-selling books about her flying experiences, and was instrumental in the formation of The Ninety-Nines, an organization for female pilots.

- Amelia Earhart built her own roller coaster.
- Amelia Earhart was the sixteenth woman to get her pilot's license.
- Amelia Earhart was the first woman to travel across the Atlantic by plane.
