As I am sure you are aware, Monday, April 8, 2024, is a very exciting day in science! The faculty at St. Margaret of Scotland School is looking forward to sharing this momentous occasion with our students. For the occasion, the PTA has purchased special viewing glasses. These glasses meet the requirements and make it safe to view the partial phases of the eclipse. The glasses that were purchased comply with the International Organization for Standardization, ISO 12312-2.

Without eye protection, it is very dangerous to look directly at the sun during the partial phases of a solar eclipse! Doing so can damage the retina of the eye. We will take great care that the students wear their eclipse viewing glasses when looking at the eclipse. However, we understand that there is an inherent risk of a student removing their glasses and looking at the sun.
