• Patrick Holley joined St. Margaret of Scotland as the new Principal of our School and quickly got to work on hiring new faculty, welcoming our students, and improving school safety.

 St. Margaret of Scotland had a successful Stewardship Season with a "Thank You" reception for volunteers, an Increased Offertory Campaign bringing in \$115,000 in new pledges, three Stewardship Fairs promoting ministries, and Nametag Sundays to help build community.

This year, St. Margaret of Scotland Music Ministry achieved milestones including purchasing new Gather hymnals and a 1996 Kawai RX3 piano through #iGiveCatholic #GivingTuesday fundraising efforts. The Ministry was also honored with the Great Preacher Award from Aquinas Institute of Theology, the first time this honor has been awarded to a group of people.

- Our Church and School buildings received many upgrades including Church door restoration, security cameras, electrical work, masonry, flooring, painting, HVAC, and more.
- The Parish and School supported the St. Joseph Housing Initiative through donations and volunteering for the Parish Lenten Project
- The SMOS community came together for some fun-draising and participated in the Feast Day 5K event in Tower Grove Park, which raised funds for end-of-year activities for the 8th Grade class.
- Living Justice Ministries at St. Margaret's Parish organized Gun Sense: For the Common Good events focusing on gun violence prevention; and Pride of St. Margaret's participated in the Tower Grove Pride festival to support LGBTQ+ friends and allies.
- The latest ministry at St. Margaret of Scotland to form this Spring is the Parents of Young Children (PYC) group with fellowship for young families, including a reconciliation service with babysitting provided, playdates for pre-pre-K children, and a coffee meet & greet for parents.
- The SMOS PTA supported the school community by organizing a landscaping project and funding school safety initiatives, such as a new fence, through events like Trivia Night.
