We will be holding auditions for the **THIRD ANNUAL PRODUCTION OF A CHARLIE BROWN CHRISTMAS**. The production is open to any SMOS student in grades 4th through 8th. This includes any parish students who are homeschooled. **No one will be turned away.** Auditions are for placement only.

AUDITION DATES: Auditions will be held on Saturday, October 19th at 1:00 PM in the Church Hall. Callbacks will be on Sunday, October 20th at 1:00 PM in the Church Hall. ROLES AVAILABLE: There are **11 SPEAKING CHARACTERS** in our production. We are adding a **SINGING CHORUS** and a **NATIVITY VIGNETTE** that adds many non-speaking parts.

AUDITION INFORMATION: Everyone will be asked to sing **HARK, THE HERALD ANGELS SING**. The music director will accompany. Anyone wanting a speaking role will be asked to memorize a short paragraph. (I will have the paragraph on a card for students to hold in case they need assistance. **NO STRESS!**) Music and monologue will be provided upon signing up for the audition time slot.

SHOW DATES: December 13 @ 7:00 PM, December 14 @ 7:00 PM, and December 15 @ 2:00 PM in the Church Hall.

REHEARSALS: All Rehearsals will be in the Church Hall on Sundays from 1:00 - 3:00 starting October 27. The singing chorus will not be rehearsing every week, so those with busy schedules may be able to participate. Tech week we will be adding rehearsals on 12/10, 12/11, and 12/12 from 5:30-7:30 PM. There will be **NO REHEARSAL** on December 1.
