FASTING ALLOWS FOR ONE FULL MEAL A DAY, WITH TWO SMALLER MEALS AND NOTHING BETWEEN MEALS (LIQUIDS ARE PERMITTED). CATHOLICS SHOULD NOT TAKE THESE RECOMMENDATIONS LIGHTLY, THOUGH SERIOUS HEALTH CONDITIONS MAY EXCUSE ONE FROM THESE OBLIGATIONS.
