What is Blood Cancer United? Formerly known as the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, they are an organization that supports blood cancer patients and their families. They provide support for research, advocacy, and patient support.

Research: They fund research into all types of blood cancer, including research being performed here in St. Louis at Washington University in St. Louis.

Advocacy: Volunteers work to elevate patient voices to state and federal officials.

Patient Support: They provide free access to resources for patients, caregivers, and healthcare officials about blood cancer. They also help patients find and enroll in eligible clinical trials, as well as help families find financial assistance for medical costs.

According to the American Cancer Society's 2025 Cancer Facts & Figures, leukemia & lymphoma make up 38.6% of all childhood cancer. Your support funds critical research to help provide better and safer treatment options for the youngest fighters.
